Dhajaggasuttam	Verses for Protection
"Araññe rukkhamūle vā, suññagāreva bhikkhavo; Anussaretha sambuddham, bhayaṁ tumhāka no siyā.	"Whether gone to the forest, to the root of a tree or dwelling in an empty space, You should remember the Sammasambuddha, and whatever fear you behold will pass away,
No ce buddham sareyyātha, lokajeṭham narāsabham; Atha dhammam sareyyātha, niyyānikam sudesitam.	If you do not recall the Buddha, the highest in the world, the foremost of men Then you should remember the Dhamma, leading to salvation, so well explained,
No ce dhammam sareyyātha, niyyānikam sudesitam; Atha saṅgham sareyyātha, puññakkhettam anuttaram	But if you don't recall the Dhamma, leading to salvation, so well explained, Then remember the Saṅgha, this endless field of merit,
Evam buddham sarantānam, dhammam saṅghañca bhikkhavo; Bhayaṁ vā chambhitattam vā, lomahamso na hessati"ti.	If in this manner you remember either the Buddha, the Dhamma or the Saṅgha, Bhikkhu, Fear, stupefaction and your hair's standing on end will no more be."
