### Dhajaggasuttaṃ

“Araññe rukkhamūle vā, suññāgāreva bhikkhavo;  
Anussaretha sambuddhaṃ, bhayaṃ tumhāka no siyā.  
No ce buddhaṃ sareyyātha, lokajetthaṃ narāsabhaṃ;  
Atha dhammaṃ sareyyātha, niyyānikaṃ sudesitaṃ.  
No ce dhammaṃ sareyyātha, niyyānikaṃ sudesitaṃ;  
Atha saṅghaṃ sareyyātha, puññakkhettaṃ anuttaraṃ.  
Evaṃ buddhaṃ sarantānaṃ, dhammaṃ saṅghaṅca bhikkhavo;  
Bhayaṃ vā chambhitattaṃ vā, lomahaṃso na hessatī”ti.

siyā	atthi(pres. opt. 3rd.sing))	should be
suññāgāreva	suññāgāra+eva	empty space + likewise
