Esa Bhagavato sāvaka-saṅgho	The Aryian Disciples
Supaṭipanno Bhagavato sāvaka-saṅgho.	"Those who have practised correctly, form the order of disciples of the Bhagavā.
Ujupaṭipanno Bhagavato sāvaka-saṅgho.	Those who have practised uprightly, form the order of disciples of the Bhagavā.
Ñāyapaṭipanno Bhagavato sāvaka-saṅgho.	Those who have practised wisely, form the order of disciples of the Bhagavā.
Sāmīcipaṭipanno Bhagavato sāvaka-saṅgho.	Those who have practised properly, form the order of disciples of the Bhagavā.
Yadidam cattāri purisa-yugāni, aṭṭha-purisa- puggalā,	That is, the four pairs of men, the eight kinds of individuals,
Esa Bhagavato sāvaka-saṅgho;	these form the order of disciples of the Bhagavā;
āhuneyyo, pāhuneyyo,	Worthy of offerings, worthy of hospitality,
dakkhineyyo, añjali-karanīyo,	Worthy of gifts and of reverent salutation,
anuttaram puññakkhettam lokassā'ti.	They are an incomparable field of merit for the world."
