Paṭhama-asappurisasuttaṃ

Sāvattthinidānaṃ. “Asappurisañca vo, bhikkhave, desessāmi, sappurisañca. Taṃ suṇātha. Katamo ca, bhikkhave, asappuriso? Idha, bhikkhave, ekacco micchādiṭṭhiko hoti, micchāsaṅkappo, micchāvāco, micchākammanto, micchā-ājīvo, micchāvāyāmo, micchāsati, micchāsamādhī- ayaṃ vuccati, bhikkhave, asappuriso.

Katamo ca, bhikkhave, sappuriso? Idha, bhikkhave, ekacco sammādiṭṭhiko hoti, sammāsaṅkappo, sammāvāco, sammākammanto, sammā-ājīvo, sammāvāyāmo, sammāsati, sammāsamādhī- ayaṃ vuccati, bhikkhave, sappuriso”ti.
