Paṭhamasāmaññasuttaṃ

Sāvattthinidānaṃ. “Sāmaññañca vo, bhikkhave, desessāmi, sāmaññaphalāni ca. Taṃ suṇātha. Katamañca, bhikkhave, sāmaññaṃ? Ayameva ariyo aṭṭhaṅgiko maggo, seyyathidaṃ– sammādiṭṭhi ...pe... sammāsamādhī. Idaṃ vuccati, bhikkhave, sāmaññaṃ. Katamāni ca, bhikkhave, sāmaññaphalāni? Sotāpattiphalaṃ, sakadāgāmiphalaṃ, anāgāmiphalaṃ, arahattaphalaṃ¹– imāni vuccanti, bhikkhave, sāmaññaphalāni”ti.

Samyuttanikāyo, Mahāvaggo, Maggasamyuttaṃ, Paṭipattivaggo

fruit of non-returning
