| Sāvatthinidānam: | This was explained in Sāvatthi: |
| "Atthime, bhikkhave, dhammā parisuddhā pariyodātā anaṅgaṇā vigatūpakkilesā anuppannā uppajjanti, | "There are, O' Bhikkhus, eight Dhammas that are utterly pure and completely spotless, without any stain left on them and are undefiled. |
| Nāññatra sugatavinayā. | They have not arisen before and arise only then when the Vinaya of the Wellgone One exists. |
| Katame aṭṭha? | What are these eight? |
| Seyyathidam— sammādiṭṭhipe sammāsamādhi. | They are right view, right thought, right speech, right action, right livelihood, right effort, right awareness and right concentration. |
| Ime kho, bhikkhave, aṭṭha dhammā parisuddhā pariyodātā anangaṇā vigatūpakkilesā anuppannā uppajjanti. | These are O' Bhikkhus, eight Dhammas that are utterly pure and completely spotless, without any stain left on them and are undefiled. |
| Nāññatra sugatavinayā''ti | They have not arisen before and arise only when the Vinaya of the Wellgone One exists." |
