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Dutiya-parisuddhasuttaṃ	Perfectly Pure - part 2
Sāvatthinidānaṃ:	This was explained in Sāvatthi:
“Aṭṭhime, bhikkhave, dhammā parisuddhā pariyodātā anaṅgaṇā vigatūpakkilesā anuppannā uppajjanti,	“There are, O’ Bhikkhus, eight Dhammas that are utterly pure and completely spotless, without any stain left on them and are undefiled.
Nāññatra sugatavinayā.	They have not arisen before and arise only then when the Vinaya of the Wellgone One exists.
Katame aṭṭha?	What are these eight?
Seyyathidaṃ– sammādiṭṭhi ...pe... sammāsamādhi.	They are right view, right thought, right speech, right action, right livelihood, right effort, right awareness and right concentration.
Ime kho, bhikkhave, aṭṭha dhammā parisuddhā pariyodātā anaṅgaṇā vigatūpakkilesā anuppannā uppajjanti.	These are O’ Bhikkhus, eight Dhammas that are utterly pure and completely spotless, without any stain left on them and are undefiled.
Nāññatra sugatavinayā”ti	They have not arisen before and arise only when the Vinaya of the Wellgone One exists.”
