<i>Asāre sāramatino, sāre cāsāradassino,</i>	<i>Perceiving the nonessential as essential, what is essential they regard as dispensable,</i>
<i>Te sāraṃ nādhigacchanti, micchāsaṅkappagocarā.</i>	<i>Thus attached to the wrong kind of thoughts they will never realize the essence.</i>
<i>Sāraṅca sārato ñatvā, asāraṅca asārato,</i>	<i>Perceiving the essential as essential, what is nonessential they regard as dispensable,</i>
<i>Te sāraṃ adhigacchanti, sammāsaṅkappagocarā.</i>	<i>Thus attached to the right kind of thoughts they will realize the essence.</i>
