Sammādiṭṭhisuttaṃ

“Catūhi, bhikkhave, dhammehi samannāgato bhikkhu apanṇakappaṭipadam paṭipanno hoti, yoni cassa āraddhā¹ hoti āsavānaṃ khayāya. Katamehi catūhi? Nekkhammavitakkena, abyāpādavitakkena, avihiṃsāvitakkena, sammādiṭṭhiyā – imehi kho, bhikkhave, catūhi dhammehi samannāgato bhikkhu apanṇakappaṭipadam paṭipanno hoti, yoni cassa āraddhā hoti āsavānaṃ khayāyā”ti.

Aṅguttaranikāyo, Catukkanipātapāli, Apanṇakavaggo, Padhānasuttaṃ

apanṇakappaṭipadam	apanṇaka + p + paṭipadam	certain, true + path
āraddhā	āraddhā	started, begun
āsavānaṃ	āsava (gen.pl)	lit: that which flows: toxicates the mind, impurities
khayāya	khaya (dat.sing.)	extinction, destruction
yoni		womb, birth

¹ *Yoni cassa āraddhā hotīti kāraṇaṅcassa paripuṇṇaṃ hoti:* ‘from the beginning determined on destruction’ the motive for completeness (of destruction)
