“Catūhi, bhikkhave, dhammehi samannāgato bhikkhu apanṇakappaṭipadaṃ paṭipanno hoti, yoni cassa āradhā hoti āsavānaṃ khayāya.	“There are four qualities, O’ Bhikkhus, if endowed with a bhikkhu has entered the assured path, from the beginning determined on the destruction of impurities.
Katamehi catūhi?	What four?
Nekkhammavitakkena, abyāpādavitakkena, avihimsāvitakkena, sammādiṭṭhiyā.	These are thoughts of dispassion, thoughts free from aversion, thoughts free from violence and right view.
