Kathāvatthu (select.)	Refuting Wrong Doctrines
Puggalo upalabbhati saccikaṭṭhaparamatthenāti. Āmantā.	"Is 'personality' perceived in the sense of real and ultimate reality?" "Certainly!"
Yo saccikattho paramattho, tato so puggalo upalabbhati saccikatthaparamatthenāti?	"Then, can 'personality' be perceived in the sense of real and ultimate reality like a real and ultimate fact is perceived?"
Na hevam vattabbe.	"That cannot truly be said so!"
Ājānāhi niggaham.	"Recognize your contradiction!
