“Katamā cānanda, pahānasaññā? Idhānanda, bhikkhu uppannaṁ kāmavitakkam nādhivāseti, pajahati, vinodeti, byantīkaroti, anabhāvam gameti. Uppannaṁ byāpādavitakkam nādhivāseti, pajahati, vinodeti, byantīkaroti, anabhāvam gameti. Uppannaṁ vihiṁsāvitakkam nādhivāseti, pajahati, vinodeti, byantīkaroti, anabhāvam gameti. Uppannuppanne pāpake akusale dhamme nādhivāseti, pajahati, vinodeti, byantīkaroti, anabhāvam gameti. Ayam vuccatānanda, pahānasaññā.
