

## Exploring the Ancient Path in the Buddha's Own Words

### Lesson 3.6.8



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#### Maṅgalasuttam

Evam me sutam – ekam samayam bhagavā sāvatthiyam viharati jetavane anāthapiṇḍikassa ārāme. Atha kho aññatarā devatā abhikkantāya rattiyā abhikkantavaññā kevalakappam jetavanam obhāsetvā yena bhagavā tenupasankami; upasaṅkamitvā bhagavantam abhivādetvā ekamantam atthāsi. Ekamantam thitā kho sā devatā bhagavantam gāthāya ajjhabhāsi –

*‘Bahū devā manussā ca, maṅgalāni acintayum;  
Ākaṅkhamānā sotthānam, brūhi mangalamuttamam’.*

*“Asevanā ca bālānam, paṇditānañca sevanā;  
Pūjā ca pūjaneyyānam, etam mangalamuttamam.*

*Patirūpadesavāso ca, pubbe ca katapuññatā;  
Attasammāpañidhi ca, etam mangalamuttamam.*

*Bāhusaccañca sippañca, vinayo ca susikkhito;  
Subhāsitā ca yā vācā, etam mangalamuttamam.*

*Mātāpitu upaṭṭhānam, puttadārassa saṅgaho;  
Anākulā ca kammantā, etam mangalamuttamam.*



*Dānañca dhammacariyā ca, ñātakānañca saṅgaho;  
Anavajjāni kammāni, etam maṅgalamuttamam.*

*Āratī viratī pāpā, majjapānā ca samyamo;  
Appamādo ca dhammesu, etam maṅgalamuttamam.*

*Gāravo ca nivāto ca, santuṭṭhi ca kataññutā;  
Kālena dhammassavanam, etam maṅgalamuttamam.*

*Khanti ca sovacassatā, samaṇānañca dassanam;  
Kālena dhammasākacchā, etam maṅgalamuttamam.*

*Tapo ca brahmacariyañca, ariyasaccāna dassanam;  
Nibbānasacchikiriyā ca, etam maṅgalamuttamam.*

*Phuṭṭhassa lokadhammehi, cittam yassa na kampati;  
Asokam virajaṁ khemam, etam maṅgalamuttamam.*

*Etādisāni katvāna, sabbathamaparājitā;  
Sabbattha sotthim gacchanti, tam tesam maṅgalamuttama''nti.*
