Idha, bhikkhave, bhikkhu anuppannānam pāpakānam akusalānam dhammānam anuppādāya chandaṁ janeti vāyamati vīriyam ārabhati cittam paggañhāti padahati, uppannānam pāpakānam akusalānam dhammānam pahānāya chandaṁ janeti vāyamati vīriyam ārabhati cittam paggañhāti padahati, anuppannānam kusalānam dhammānam uppādāya chandaṁ janeti vāyamati vīriyam ārabhati cittam paggañhāti padahati, uppannānam kusalānam dhammānam t̄hitiyā asammosāya bhiyyobhāvāya vepullāya bhāvanāya pāripūriyā chandaṁ janeti vāyamati vīriyam ārabhati cittam paggañhāti padahati— ayam vuccati, bhikkhave, sammāvāyāmo.”
